Dear Friends of Voices:

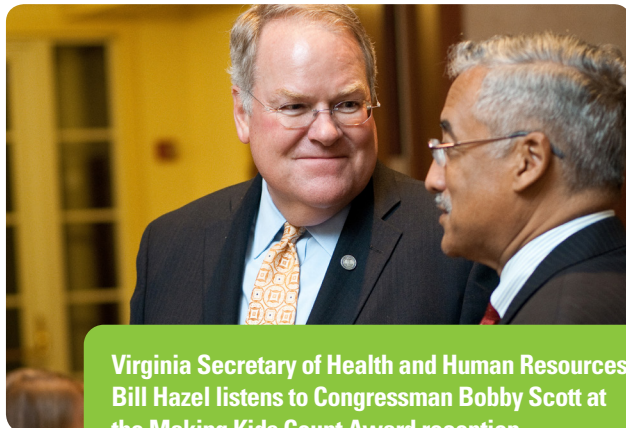
We send you spring greetings, coupled with a sincere thank you for the support you've rendered since our last correspondence. Voices continues to make a tangible impact in communities throughout Virginia, in large part due to your caring and commitment.

With your help, our first-ever Carol S. Fox Making Kids Count Award reception was a sold-out success. The October event helped us raise awareness about the policy endeavors and collaborative work Voices champions on behalf of Virginia's children, while publicly saluting two of our exemplary child advocacy partners: individual winner Johanna Schuchert of Prevent Child Abuse Virginia and United Methodist Family Services as the organizational selection.

In addition, your letters, emails and calls to state legislators during the 2013 General Assembly session helped us make advances in children's mental health funding, support services and education access for youth in foster care, and additional funds for early intervention and home visiting programs that will tangibly enhance the lives of thousands of Virginia children.

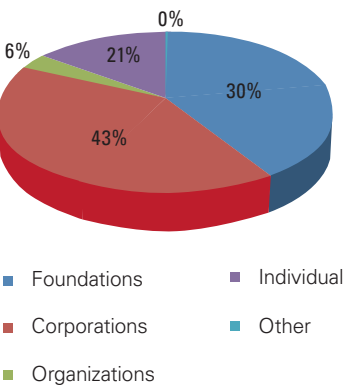

Schedule of Income for 2012

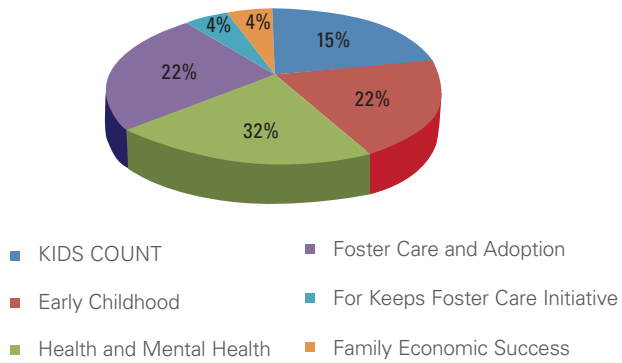
