

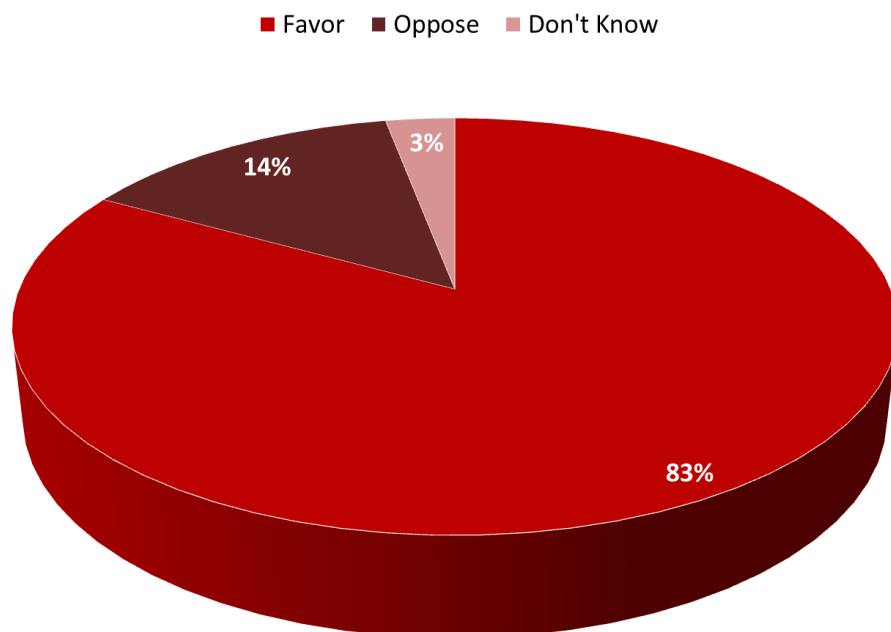
VIRGINIA VOTERS SUPPORT

4 out of 5 voters (83%) favor a plan to help uninsured people access health care.

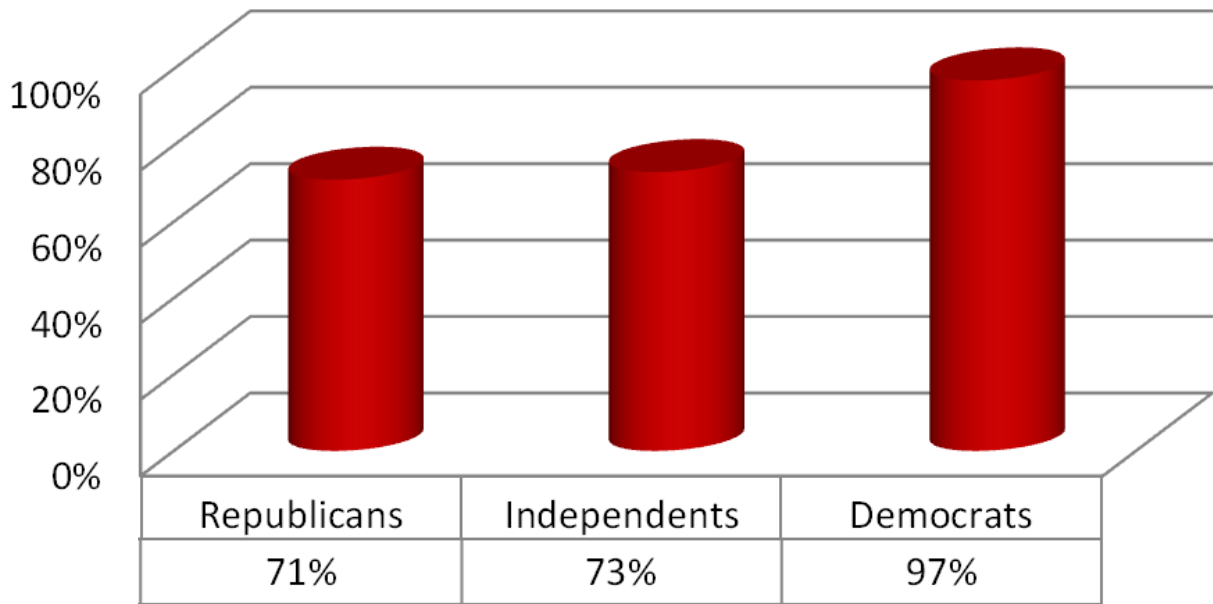
Broad support for health care coverage
